

## June Deadlines with US Treasury and IRS for Overseas Filers

Americans living abroad are entitled to an automatic [2 month extension](#). If you use a calendar year, the regular due date of your return is April 15, and the automatic extended due date would be June 15.

The special June 15th filing deadline applies to:

É U.S. citizens and resident aliens who both live and work outside the United States

É Members of the military on duty outside the United States

Taxpayers taking advantage of this extension must attach a statement to their return indicating which of these applies. Taxpayers with foreign accounts whose aggregate value exceeded \$10,000 at any time during 2012 must file Treasury Department Form [TD F 90-22.1](#). This is not a tax form and is **due to the Treasury Department by June 30, 2013**.
